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_____ PM **Dollar Dance.** As with the bouquet and garter toss, the dollar dance usually happens at least 30 minutes after the Wedding Party Dance. Pick 2-3 songs, these are normally slow songs. If we see after 1 or 2 songs there is no need for another, we'll just leave it at that.

_____ PM **Longest Married Couple Dance.** This is where all married couples are asked to dance, then after about 30 seconds, the DJ will announce "If you have been married for less than a year, please sit down", then after another short time period "If you have been married less than 5 years please sit down" and it goes on down the line until the longest married couple is the only couple remaining on the dance floor. Oftentimes we find that the longest married couple has been married for 20-35 years! Sometimes the longest married couple will receive a small prize such as a bouquet of flowers but this is definitely not required. If you are interested in this dance being done, please write yes on the line below and if there are certain songs you'd like played for this song please write the names of the songs and artists (normally we will need atleast 2 songs for this)
